

DPAC AKA Aloha Swimming Pool Rules

Absolutely no pool or facility entry if you or your children have a fever or cough are sneezing, have diarrhea, open sores, or any other contagious illness.

Masks required for parents in parent & tot classes.

1. For safety, the facility, pool, and parking areas are monitored 24/7 by video surveillance.
2. Children under the age of 14 must enter and exit the facility with parental supervision. Parents/guardians are to monitor and “lifeguard” their own children at all times.
3. Swimmers with long hair must wear a cap or hair bands to keep hair out of eyes. No metal clips.
4. Sunscreen must be applied at home in advance.
5. If your child is not potty trained, or there is a chance of accident, they must be in swim diapers AND no leak seal pants. There is a \$100 fee for accidents in the pool when precautions were not taken.
6. All diapers need to be changed next to the changing area, and used diapers need to be disposed of in the marked container.
7. No smoking, alcohol, or drugs anywhere on the facility including the parking areas.
8. No eating in the pool. No gum or glass on the premises.
9. No diving unless with the instructor during the lesson.
10. No running, rough housing, throwing objects in or around the pool.
11. No pushing others on the pool deck or in the water.
12. There are no showers or changing rooms so shower and change at home.
13. Port a potty is for emergencies only. Please use your restroom prior to your arrival.
14. No climbing hanging or sitting on tables, equipment, trees or anything else that poses risk or possible damage.
15. If you break it, you pay for it. This is a private non-commercial facility and although we will make every effort to resolve any problems or issues, we reserve the right to refuse service to those who cannot follow the rules and policies.

I have read and understand the Pool/Facility rules as defined above. I understand and agree that disciplinary measures, such as time outs, loss of practice/play time or even ending of the current lesson may be implemented for disregarding rules.
